

Xaayda<u>G</u>a Gwaay.yaay Located North west coast of Canada, just south of Alaska, U.S. A.










A recent and powerful force

- by 1957 evidence of deer at SGang Gwaay World Heritage Site.







- -• Logging company plans include logging Kiid.

- 1993 Canadian Government declares area anNational Park Reserve.






Sitka black-tailed deer browsing young trees








Shoreline before


Shoreline after



Cedar requires the understory to cause them to reach for the sunlight, grow tall without branches from the bottom to the midway up to the top.














Salal understory in absence of deer






Losing the plants means losing the animals



The wind "Kayd Kaajii
Xaatl'l" (He takes the head off
the tree), the lack of understory
to anchor trees and
combination of drying and
rains loosens the soil around
the roots now causes the large
trees to topple over instead of
breaking off.
